3. The RDC reports to the College Research Committee. The Committee is scheduled to meet termly (or as required).
The RDC will consult annually with the Researcher Development Advisory Board (to be established in 2022). The Committee will update the Advisory Board on progress and draw on the board members' expertise to shape and evaluate the career development provision at the College.

Concordat specific duties

With the College being a signatory to the [Concordat to Support the Career Development of Researchers](#), it is the responsibility of the Researcher Development Committee:

- x To ensure that the College implements the Concordat principles and fulfils its obligations under the key responsibilities for researchers, managers of researchers and institution.
- x To oversee the completion of the Concordat actions as laid out in the [Concordat Action Plan](#).
- x To ensure that the action plan complements other key initiatives, such as Race Equality Charter and AthenaISAN
- x To monitor action progress termly, with a full report submitted annually to the Provosts Board in addition to an updated action plan.
- x To publish the action plan and subsequent annual progress report on an open website once they have been endorsed by the Provost's Board.
